Applied Biology

The Regs¹:

- 4
- ...relates to providing advice or another service for a biology objective that, having regard to the protective purposes, requires the experience or technical knowledge of a [registrant].
- 1(1):
 - "biology objective" means the restoration, retention or enhancement of, or the mitigation of impacts on, the receiving environment, and the living organisms, habitats or processes within ecosystems in relation to
 - (a) conservation,
 - (b) protection, or
 - (c) wild terrestrial or aquatic species management;



Applied Biology


